### **Month 1: The Call to Speak/Write**

- What's your story, and how has your story shaped your life?
- Where is your story holding you hostage?
- Why rewrite your story for God's glory!

### **Month 2: People, Places, and Pain**

- What pain have you learned to carry quietly, and how has it influenced your voice, choices, or confidence?
- How has pain paralyzed you, impacted relationships, or caused you not to trust God or others?
- How do you break free from the people and places that caused you pain?

### **Month 3: Labels, Lies, and Identity**

- What names or narratives have followed you longer than they should have?
- How has God already been at work redefining who you are beyond the lies and labels?
- What truth is God inviting you to receive about who you are now, not who you were?

### **Month 4: Strategy, Strength, and Courage**

- What moments in your story required courage, wisdom, or discernment rather than reaction?
- What lessons did you learn to share as tools, tips, or wisdom with a woman in a similar situation?
- How might God be using your story as a turning point in your life to redirect you to purpose?

### **Month 5: God's Promises with Purpose**

- What promises has God spoken into your life that required patience, faith, or surrender?
- How have seasons of waiting shaped your story, your trust in God, and clarified your purpose?
- What might God be forming in you while you wait, and not just what you're waiting for?

### **Month 6: Redemption - Your Story, God's Glory**

- How has God redeemed your life through your story?
- Whom might God be calling you to reach through your testimony?
- What does it look like to steward your story with wisdom, courage, and purpose?
